



### CRA DISCLOSURE REPORTS

At the end of each calendar year, the bank submits certain loan data to the government as required by the Community Reinvestment Act. The government then compiles various reports from the submitted data and makes the reports available to the public. #### STEPS TO FOLLOW

1. Select applicable Year and enter "0000011063" for Respondent ID. Then click "Retrieve by Institutions."
2. Select applicable metropolitan statistical area and then click "Select MSA/MD."
3. Select desired report and click "Retrieve Report."
4. If desired, print copy of report.
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 for each desired report.
